Gym/Hall Update

The latest communication from the Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA) was sent via a Compass Newsfeed earlier this week informing us that the completion of the gym/hall will go back to tender in the near future. Unfortunately, this all takes time and I am very limited in that process until we re-instate the Project Control Group (PCG) at re-tender stage. In the meantime, I am working with the VSBA Project Manager to at least get the works at the front of school completed prior to the re-mobilisation of the whole project, as the limited access is very annoying for everyone.

One piece of good news is that we were able to take over some aspects of the upgrade to the admin area, with the completion of the new First Aid Room to be available for use in Term 3. This room is adjacent to the office and will enable a better level of care when students are sick or injured. One small but important step forward during this frustrating time.

I thank everyone for their patience and I can assure the community that the project will be completed, just later than we expected. It will be a significant 'game changer' for our school and the local community once fully operational.

Last Assembly for Term 2

Our end of term assembly will be held on the last day - Friday 23 June at 1:45pm. Highlights will include performances from our Senior Vocal Ensemble, the VSSS Dance Squad and our Rock Band. All parents/carers are invited to attend and celebrate the final day of Term 2. Students will be dismissed at 2:30pm.

Assembly Trial Term 3

Next term, we will be trialling a change to our weekly assembly which will take place on a *Friday* at 3.00pm to end the week. This enables classroom teachers to maximise Monday mornings as optimal learning time and settle into their routine for the week. We hope that it will also enable an increased number of parents/carers to attend regularly. Feedback will be sought from the community (students, teachers and parents/carers) post-trial, to inform a more substantive decision moving forward.


Long Service Leave

DON'T FORGET THE SLIP! EARLY

When collecting your child early or dropping them off late, the Compass kiosk in the front office must always be your first stop to sign your child in/out before heading to the classroom. The correct slip (green for early departure, orange for late arrival) needs to be given to your child's teacher, indicating they have been signed in/out. Without entering your child at the Compass kiosk, their attendance and whereabouts will not be amended. Thank-you for your cooperation with this important process.

broke a sugar square with water.






On Thursday we had a science incursion. We made a tornado and a cloud and rain with shaving cream. We learnt about weather and had lots of fun.





