## From our Acting Principal:

#### **Parent Opinion Survey**

In the coming week, a link to the Department of Education's Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey will be distributed to a random sample of families. This annual survey is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate and student engagement, and provides important data that helps track our performance against the School Strategic Plan goals. The survey results provide themes for School Leadership and/or School Council to explore in greater depth, and helps inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

Whilst optional, we encourage all families identified through the random selection to participate. The survey will be conducted online, takes approximately 20 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the survey period - Monday 7 August to Friday 8 September.

#### **Gym/Hall Update**

Earlier this week, the VSBA provided a brief update on the gym/hall build. At this point in time, the project delivery team are in the process of preparing documentation to call for tenders from builders as part of a retendering process. VSBA Project Delivery will appoint a project manager to oversee this process and act as superintendent during construction works once a builder has been appointed. Atelier Wagner Architects will remain involved as the principal design consultants.

While we don't yet have a firm timeframe for when tenders will be released, we will continue to work with the VSBA to ensure the school and construction site is safe and secure until a builder is appointed.

#### **Term 3 Parent/Carer Learning Support Document**

Earlier this week, Term 3 Parent/Carer Learning Support documents were sent out via Compass Newsfeed. As part of our work around the explicit teaching of social and emotional learning lessons, year level teams are now incorporating this wellbeing learning foci into support documents to enable parents/carers opportunities to reinforce the language and learning at home.

Parents/carers may wish to use the suggestions to reinforce home-school learning connections in curriculum areas through:

- prompting discussions and questions
- linking everyday learning opportunities back to key concepts and themes that are being taught in the classroom and specialist subjects
- > exploring additional ways to apply understandings in other contexts.

These documents will continue to remain accessible on Compass Newsfeeds during the term and are also accessible on our school website under the Communication tab.

Please help the Admin Team out by NOT entering medical/dental appointments, etc, through your Compass Parent Portal – simply follow the early departure / late arrival procedure when you come in to drop off or collect your child.

## COVID Requirements Update

As of July 10, Victorian schools are no longer required to keep records of student COVID cases, however the DET recommendation remains in place that any staff or students who test positive for COVID should stay home for 5 days minimum and only return to school when they are symptom-free. We kindly ask that you continue to inform office staff or your child's teacher if your child tests positive for COVID. Free rapid antigen tests are still available at the front office. Thank you for your continued co-operation.
